## Fall full of events for HCEC

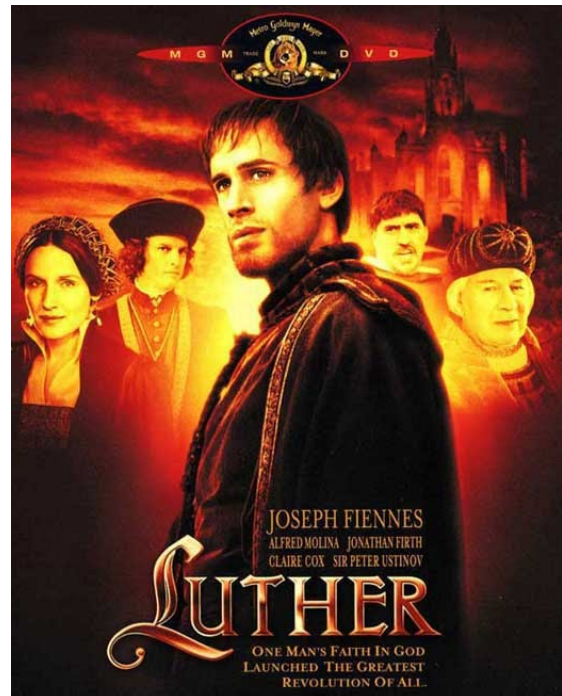
Late October and November will prove to be a busy time for Holy Comforter Episcopal Church.

Peach Street Farmers Market will hold its first Harvest Festifall on Saturday, Oct. 28 from 8 am to noon. The event will feature the regular vendors as well as costume contests and entertainment.

The Peach Street Film Society will feature the film *Luther* on Oct. 26 to honor the 500th anniversary of Martin Luther nailing his 95 Theses on the doors of the church at Wittenberg, Germany.

Celebrating the anniversary of the Reformation will continue through Sunday, Oct. 29, when HCEC will have its own Reformation Sunday, a liturgical celebration of the Reformation. Fr. Travis says the service will feature Reformed hymns like "A Mighty Fortress is Our God," penned by Martin Luther.

On Nov. 1, All Saints' Day, HCEC will have a contemplative Service of the Light at 7 pm (preceded by dinner at 6 pm). Fr. Travis says this service is a blend of Day of the Dead and All Saints' Day. Loved ones who have passed away
